## Agreement to Serve as a Member of the Board of Directors<sup>1</sup>

Having been selected to serve as a director of the Association, I voluntarily agree, as a member of the Board, to:

- 5. Actively participate as a board member by regularly attending meetings, preparing for meetings, contributing to board discussions, and showing up for special events
- 6. Refrain from counselling, advising, or giving direction, as an individual board member, to staff members or volunteers
- 7. Support decisions of the board even if I do not always agree
- 8. Wherever and whenever possible be a champion for Association and its work in the community
